

# TEAS INFORMATION

## Overview

The Assessment Technologies Institute Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI-TEAS) is a computer-based test that is designed to assess a student's preparedness to enter the health science field. The exam takes approximately 209 minutes and includes 170 multiple choice questions from the following content areas:

- Reading - key ideas and details, craft and structure, integration of knowledge and ideas
- Math - numbers and algebra, measurement and data
- Science - human anatomy and physiology, life and physical sciences, scientific reasoning
- English - conventions of standard English, knowledge of language, vocabulary acquisition

Students who do not obtain the required score on one or more parts of the exam may retest. Students must wait 30 days between test dates and will only be allowed to test 3 times per year.
