

# NLN NACE I INFORMATION

## Overview

The National League for Nursing (NLN) offers the Nursing Acceleration Challenge Exam (NACE) which provides diagnostic evaluation of the student's nursing knowledge. The NACE is designed to evaluate previous learning and experience in order to establish credit and administration to licensed practical nurses seeking placement in programs preparing for registered nursing practice.

## Retesting

Students who do not obtain the required score on the exam may retest. Students must wait 30 days between test dates and will only be allowed to test 3 times during one calendar year.

# A&P CHALLENGE EXAM

Students applying for the LPN to RN bridge track or the Paramedic to RN bridge track have the opportunity to test out of the BI151 Anatomy and Physiology I class. Students must achieve a 75% or higher on this exam to receive credit for the class.

This exam is not required at the time of admission but must be completed prior to orientation. At orientation you will receive a copy of your schedule for the upcoming semester and you will be enrolled in BI151 Anatomy and Physiology I if a passing exam score has not been received by that time.
