Paramedics are now being accepted into the accelerated nursing program that has traditionally been limited to LPN to RN students. The paramedic to RN student accepted into this tract will finish in the accelerated tract in 10 months. Classes will be held daily rather than Monday and Thursday in order to complete requirements of this course of study.

The ADN program has full time LPN to RN Bridge, Paramedic to RN, Basic tract ADN programs of study. Also available is evening-weekend part-time options for LPN and Paramedic to RN tracts as well as Basic tract students.
