

NURSING POLICY CHANGE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Readmission to Nursing Program

The following criteria must be met for consideration of readmission to the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing Program.

1. If the number of students applying for readmission exceeds the number of available seats in nursing program, applicants with the highest GPA will be given preference.
2. Students who fail (<78%) Fundamentals of Nursing course (NS 101) or Bridging to Professional Practice (NS 105) will not be readmitted to the nursing program.
3. Students dismissed for clinical violation of professional behavior/conduct will not be readmitted.
4. Students who apply for readmission will be readmitted contingent upon successful demonstration of previously learned competencies in nursing skills and physical examination/assessment, passing ($\geq 90\%$) a dosage calculation exam, and passing ($\geq 78\%$) a comprehensive exam based on information from all prior passed nursing courses. These tests/competencies will be administered once. There will be a \$100 processing fee. The competency testing may not be repeated.
5. A minimum GPA of 2.5 in nursing courses is required for readmission to the nursing program.
6. Students may reapply to a program only once. They will have a maximum of two attempts to complete the College program.
